



❖ **Are there any prerequisites to my overnight visit?**

Once you request an overnight visit, you will receive a Prospective Student *Overnight Policy and Release form* via email, which must be completed and returned to the admissions office prior to your visit.

❖ **How are visiting students paired with a student host?**

Our male or female overnight host coordinator (a current student) will match you with one of our volunteer hosts (also current students), based upon their availability on that particular date. If possible, we try to match you with someone of similar interests, though this may not always be the case. Once matched, you will receive an email that confirms your visit.

❖ **What do I need to bring with me to campus?**

You will want to bring a sleeping bag, pillow, rollup mat (if you have one), toiletries, a towel, and any personal items you may desire to make your overnight stay more comfortable. Depending on the design of the host student's room, there may not be an available bed on which to sleep.

❖ **Will meals be provided for me?**

You will receive a *Guest Meal Pass*, courtesy of the Admissions Office, which can be used for your dinner on the evening of your overnight. Since overnights are offered in conjunction with an Admissions Event the following day, you will be offered refreshments the next morning along with that event.

❖ **Do I need to bring money with me?**

It is advised that you *do* bring money with you, just in case you desire something beyond that which is already provided for you.

❖ **When will my visit begin?**

Meet your overnight host at the entrance to the Admissions Office at 4:15 p.m. Please be prompt. Your overnight visit begins as soon as you are joined with your host!

❖ **Are pre-planned activities provided for the evening?**

No activities are arbitrarily scheduled for you and your host. We want you to feel free to explore the campus and all that it has to offer under the care of your host. In this way, you will gain an understanding of what it is like to live in a dorm as a "Grover." Please keep in mind that (for liability reasons) your host has been instructed that you are not permitted to ride in their car. [NOTE: If there is something specific that you would like to do while on campus, please notify your host.]

❖ **How long will my visit last?**

Your visit will last until the event begins the following day. Be sure to make arrangements with your host to gather all of your belongings at an agreeable time that day.

❖ **What if I become ill while on campus?**

Your host will notify the RA (Resident Advisor), who will then notify the RD (Resident Director) of the residence hall. The RD will have a copy of your form with the needed emergency contact information and will handle matters from there.
